The Drinking Water Bureau of the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED-DWB) has received and reviewed your NELAP certification /accreditation information from the state of New Jersey. The documentation is acceptable and your New Mexico certification is now valid through June 30, 2010.

This certification is to perform drinking water analysis in compliance with the Federal Safe Drinking Water Act, pursuant to 40CFR Part 141, and the New Mexico Environment Department Drinking Water Regulations for the Primary Regulated contaminants, including contaminants as listed in your New Jersey Scope Accreditation.

You must advise NMED-DWB of any change in your accreditation by the State of New Jersey and continue to provide this office with performance evaluation results. You are also required to provide evidence of renewal of accreditation by the state of New Jersey to continue certification past June 30, 2010.

Laboratories certified by New Mexico can be purged from the list if there is no evidence that they are performing drinking water compliance sample analysis for public water supply systems in New Mexico.
