Coelomycetes

Natural Habitat

- ◆ Plants (acting as saprophyte and pathogen)
- ◆ Other fungi
- ◆ Lichens

Suitable Substrates in the Indoor Environment

- ◆ Ceiling Tiles
- ◆ Floor Tiles

Mode of Dissemination

- ◆ Insects
- ◆ Water Splash
- ◆ Wind

Allergenic Potential

- ◆ Type I (hay fever, asthma)

Potential Opportunist or Pathogen

- ◆ Genera dependant

Industrial Uses

- ◆ Unknown

Potential Toxins Produced

- ◆ Unknown

Additional Comments

- ◆ These are asexual fungi that form conidia in pycnidia or acervuli (asexual fruiting structures). Examples of Coelomycete fungi include *Phoma* and *Pestalotia*
