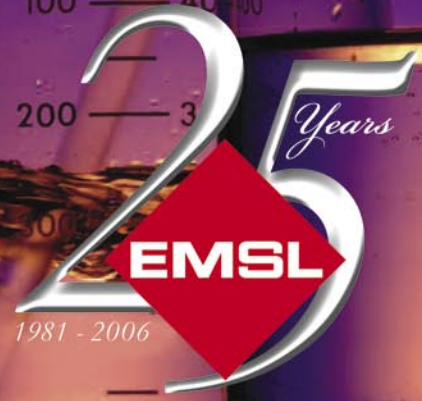

Ulocladium

Suitable Substrates in the Indoor Environment	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◆ Gypsum board◆ Jute◆ Paper◆ Rotten wood◆ Textiles◆ Wood

Allergenic Potential	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◆ Type I (hay fever, asthma)
